Throughout the year, the debutantes and their families attend themed parties and social gatherings hosted in their

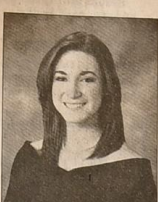

Saturday at the Sarasota Municipal Auditorium.

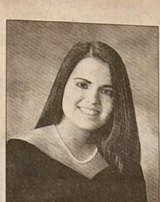
